Description

This old school was built in the 19th century to educate the local village children. It saw many years of service through two World Wars and was finally closed down in 2009 when a new school was built. The current owners bought the building and have painstakingly renovated it to accommodate three holiday gites of 3 bedrooms, 3 bedrooms and 3 bedrooms.

Each bedroom has its own en suite bathroom. All the gites are very spacious and come fully-equipped. The ground floor living areas are expansive and offer open kitchen, dining area and sitting/TV area. The three houses can be locked off for single family occupancy or opened up for multiple family or group accommodation.

The owners have gone out of their way to ensure that guests will enjoy a comfortable home-from-home ambience beneath the Mediterranean skies.

Overview

Set within the heart of thriving Roujan this old school has been painstakingly converted into three spacious gites with shared pool. Each gite has its own large terrace with outdoor furniture and direct access to the lovely tiled pool and plage area. Every bedroom is en suite and the ground floors benefit from air conditioning. Restaurant

There are several restaurants in Roujan to choose from. Let us know if you'd like a recommendation.

The popular town of Pézenas is 10 minutes by car. Well worth a visit for its Saturday market and its many interesting artisan shops and boutiques. A weekly food market is hosted outside the Roujan town hall every Thursday morning from 8 am to 12 pm. There you will find locally grown fruit and vegetables, as well as locally made goat and sheep cheese. The Pézenas market is held on Saturday mornings and includes food and beverage stalls such as fresh meats, cheese, olives, fruit and farmed vegetables. They also sell household items, toys and clothing. It attracts people from far and wide.

Festivals and fairs are aplenty in the region during the spring and summertime. Each local village holds it's own "Fête" and these are planned

on weekends in the Spring and summer.

Pézenas and Béziers both hold evening wine and food festivals, called "Éstivales", are held one evening a week in July and August. This is a time to showcase the local wineries and includes food stalls and local musicians. Beaches:

Cap d'Agde attracts tourists with its sandy beaches, boardwalk restaurants and history.

Marseillan Plage is a beautiful beachside location that includes a harbour, quaint restaurants and freshly caught seafood.

The seaside town of Sète hosts a water jousting competition every summer. The town is located on one end of the Étang de Thau, a local Oyster and Mussel farming area. There are numerous small restaurants along the Étang that prepare and serve various seafood.

Some of the other popular beach areas include Vias Plage, Vendres Plage and Mèze.

Lakes and Rivers:

Barrage des Olivettes – located close to Vailhan, this man-made lake is a result of the damming of the Peyne river. It is frequented by many locals for swimming and picnicking.


The River Orb is located to the northwest of Béziers. Many people visit this river to enjoy white water canoeing.

The Pont du Diable located close to the pottery-making village of Saint Jean de Fos is popular among locals and tourists. It is an almost 20 metre high bridge that dates from the first half of the 11th century. It spans the Hérault river and attracts daredevils who choose to risk injury by jumping. While illegal, many thrill seekers still take the chance and jump. Meanwhile, swimmers, cliff jumpers and canoe and stand up paddle boarders enjoy the currents, rock formations and scenery all around.

The Lac du Salagou is located roughly 30 km from Roujan. It is a reservoir of the Salagou dam and is characterized by its rich red clay earth and hill formations. The site of previous volcanic activity, it is a mecca for watersports and hiking. In addition, the Canadair water planes for the regional fire department use this lake to fill their tanks for fighting local fires. Quite a spectacular sight to see!
